### **TALK TIME**

Help the children use the language they learn through the songs:  
Can I have a pencil, please?

This will take time so be patient. Give them lots of practice.

A: Can I have a pencil, please? /Please give me a pencil.

B: Here you are.

A: Thank you.

B: You're welcome.

The songs may be a little difficult for them to memorize but some parts e.g. the following chorus can be learnt easily:

Please and thank you
