

COLOURS (1)

Too many colours may confuse the children so start with just *red/blue/yellow/green*. More colours are taken up in Sets 2 and 3.

You can take up 1 colour over 2 or 3 days (or even longer).
You could spend 5-10 minutes each day.

Suppose you start with **red**.
You can wear something red.
Collect lots of red things you can show the children.
If you can't bring an apple, get a picture or draw an apple.

The children could pick up the things and say:
Red apple, red cap, red car etc.

If there are children wearing something red, you can talk about their clothes.

Let the children colour an apple or fill an outline of the fruit with bits of red paper.

Base your activities around the colour **red**.

Similarly do it with *green, blue* and *yellow*.

VIDEO

This video takes up only 4 colours: red/blue/green/yellow
red apple/ blue sky/ yellow sun/ green grass

Give the students lots of practice with these 4 colours.
Keep repeating red apple/ blue sky/ yellow sun/ green grass.

Then try making them say:
The apple is red.
The sky is blue.
(Once they learn the song *What Colour is the Sky?* it should be easier for them.)

Take them outside and show them the sky, sun and grass.
If you display pictures of these things in the classroom, the children will learn the phrases very fast.

Bring objects of these 4 colours to class.
OR
Draw red/blue/yellow and green balls on paper.
Let the children pick up one at a time and say 'red ball' blue ball' etc.

Let them use numbers and colours together:

2 red balls/ 4 blue balls

Talk about the colour of the children's clothes:

red skirt/ blue shirt

And later on:

Tina's skirt is red /Tina is wearing a red skirt.

Aman's shirt is blue/Aman is wearing a blue shirt.

Think of different ways in which you can keep repeating the colours and using them with various objects.
