What are you doing?

I'm walking.

I'm running.

I'm jumping.

I'm dancing.

I'm reading.

I'm eating.

I'm drinking.

I'm sleeping.

I'm putting on my shoes.

I'm putting on my hat.

I'm saying goodbye.

Goodbye!

Make the children chant:

walk/walking/I'm walking.

run/running/I'm running etc.

They can do the actions too. If a child is wearing shoes you can make him/her take off the shoes and put them on, saying *I'm putting on my shoes*. You could use a hat too.

What are you doing?

I'm sitting in a chair*.

I'm pushing a cart.

I'm pulling a wagon.

I'm singing a song.

I'm reading a book.

I'm washing my hands.

I'm brushing my hair.

I'm drying my hair.

*There is a problem with the sentence: I'm sitting *in* a chair. It should be *on* a chair. Make the children say: *on a chair*.

Remember, *in a chair* can be used if the chair has arms/if it closes around you.
