

CLOTHES

VIDEO Clothes

T-shirt/jeans/shirt/pants/shorts/dress/skirt/blouse/socks/shoes

The children would already be familiar with names of most items of clothing. They can be made to look at each other's clothes and talk about them every day.

You can point to your clothes and say: I am wearing a _____.

Ask the children: What are you wearing? /What is Maya wearing? etc.

Let them answer: jeans/shirt/dress etc.

Later on you can try making them say:

I am wearing a shirt/a dress etc.

BUT

I am wearing jeans/pants/shorts/socks/shoes (article 'a' not used).

When you show them the slides, pause at the slide with the picture of a dress and ask: Who is wearing a dress?

Let them raise hands or call out names.

Do it similarly for other clothes.

Use colours and numbers while talking about clothes.

Maya is wearing a red dress. Who is wearing a blue dress?

How many children are wearing T-shirts?

You can easily use pictures from newspapers and magazines to talk about clothes.
