bakery - I buy bread at the bakery.
bank - I keep my money in the bank.
bookstore - I buy books at the bookstore.
bus stop - I catch a bus at the bus stop.
cake shop - I buy cake at the cake shop.
coffee shop - Daddy drinks coffee at the coffee shop.
dentist - I go to the dentist when I have a toothache.
doctor's office - I go to the doctor's office when I'm sick.
drug store - I buy medicine at the **drug store**.
flower shop - I buy flowers at the flower shop.

gas station - Mommy buys **gasoline** at the **gas station**.
hospital - I go to the hospital when I'm sick.

Drug store, gasoline and gas station are used in American English; you could tell the children to use chemist, petrol and petrol station.

pharmacy, supermarket, stadium, restaurant, theater, gas station, mall, parking lot, book store, police station, hair salon and airport

Gas station is used in American English; you could tell the children petrol station.

Pharmacy: A shop that sells medicines is also called a chemist shop.
