They can try adding: I look after people when they are sick or hurt. 2. What does a postman do? A postman delivers letters and packages. After watching the videos, children can be made to ask and answer: What do you want to be? Let the children practise saying the sentences. After they become familiar with the sentences, you could say some words and let the children form a sentence. e.g. baker /bread/ cakes.
